Paragraph for member request letters going to the House and Senate Agriculture Appropriations Subcommittees:

I support the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP), which helps low-income Americans improve their diets and increase physical activity. EFNEP, now in its 35th year, helps some 600,000 people each year (roughly 75 percent children) to gain new skills in food preparation, storage, safety, and sanitation. They also learn how to better manage their food budgets and related resources such as Food Stamps. Youth topics also include fitness, avoidance of substance abuse, and other health-related issues. I support a funding level of \$62.0 million for EFNEP.
